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NASHVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY EXPANDS BOARD GAME COLLECTION

Board game enthusiasts now have 440 games to borrow — for free

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — Nashville board game fans can now borrow up to 440 games for free with their Nashville Public [Library card](#) — thanks to NPL's recent expansion of its [Board Game Collection](#).

Launched in 2021 with just 30 selections, the Board Game Collection quickly gathered steam and now includes 440 classic and modern titles, from *Sorry!* to *Settlers of Catan*. To date, Library patrons have checked out games more than 6,900 times.

"The Library collection offers a wide array of items — including our newly expanded Board Game Collection — giving people yet another way to experience the library beyond just books," said NPL Director Terri Luke. "We love seeing how this program encourages people to gather, relax and connect with one another, and we are incredibly grateful to Mayor O'Connell and Metro Nashville for the investments that made this possible."

The board games are housed at the Main Library as well as at 10 branches: Bordeaux, Donelson, Edgehill, Edmondson Pike, Goodlettsville, Green Hills, Hadley Park, Hermitage, Looby and Madison.
