12th ANNIVERSARY LEGO CONTEST BEGINS FEBRUARY 12 AT LIBRARY

Registration Open for Entries Now Until February 11

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Children, teens and adults from across Nashville will proudly display their original LEGO creations at Nashville Public Library's 12th annual LEGO Contest. Entrants are challenged to use their own bricks to create original pieces, which they can drop off at NPL beginning Saturday, Feb. 12.

From Saturday, Feb. 19 through Monday, Feb. 22, all entries will be displayed virtually for crowd viewing and voting for Crowd Favorites.

A panel of judges will award first through third place and crowd favorite prizes in six categories: preschool-K, grades 1-2, grades 3-4, grades 5-7, grades 8-12 and adults. Winners will be announced on Saturday, Feb. 26 during a virtual awards ceremony.

Winners receive a prize ribbon and LEGO Store gift certificate. Entries selected as Crowd Favorites by viewers will also be recognized.
