Title: Belmont Garden Club Collection

Summary: A collection of meeting minutes, organizational records, and printed materials documenting the activities and history of the Belmont Garden Club.

Dates range from 1931 to 2002. Bulk dates: 1935-1979.

Historical Note:

The Belmont Garden Club was first organized in the late fall of 1929 (exact date unknown), with the purpose to promote gardening and to cooperate in the protection and conservation of wildlife. In early 1930, a group of Nashville women met for the purpose of electing club officers and setting up committees. As most of the club members lived in the Belmont area, it was decided that the name of the club would be the "Belmont Garden Club," and members met on a monthly basis.

In 1934, the Belmont Garden Club was admitted to the Tennessee Federation of Garden Clubs. Since then, members have been active in horticulture, flower arranging, civic improvements, beautification projects, and fostering interest in garden programs. The club has collaborated with other institutions and organizations such as Cheekwood, the Red Cross, and the Centennial Club.

Scope and Contents of the Collection:

The Belmont Garden Club Collection contains meeting minutes, organizational records, and printed materials documenting the activities, programs, and history of the Belmont Garden Club. Dates of the collection range between 1931 to 2002, with bulk dates between 1935 and 1979. Though the club was founded in 1929, its earliest records have been lost; however, the collection contains written

recollections of charter members about the club's early history. The collection contains a wide variety of materials, including photographs from events, programs, memorial resolutions for deceased club members, correspondence, and a large collection of club yearbooks. Also included is an unboxed scrapbook containing handwritten lists of officers, members, programs, speakers, and the constitution and by-laws of the Belmont Garden Club. The collection comprises approximately 1.7 linear feet.
