### Scope and Contents of the Collection:

The County Judge Papers are comprised of correspondence, court papers, inventories, reports and documents relating to various projects within Nashville and Davidson County. This collection reflects administrative activities related to the Davidson County Judge, namely Hon. Litton Hickman (1875-1956) and Hon. C. Beverly Briley (1914-1980). A large portion of this collection includes property acquisition records for the construction of Nashville's interstate system during the late 1950s and early 1960s, most of which contain photographs of the properties acquired. Also included in the County Judge Papers are general and financial reports from other government departments, court-related related records such as decrees, pardons, and state highway cases, and correspondence with other departments.
