NPL TO CELEBRATE MAIN LIBRARY'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — On Saturday, June 13, Nashville Public Library will [celebrate the 25th anniversary](#) and recent reopening of the [Main Library](#), 615 Church St., in downtown Nashville.

The iconic, 300,000-square-foot space opened to the public on June 9, 2001. It showcases one-of-a-kind spaces like the [Civil Rights Room](#), [Votes for Women Room](#), [Metro Archives](#) and the [Children's Theater](#), which is home to NPL's in-house puppet troupe, [Wishing Chair Productions](#).

The celebratory bash, free and open to everyone, will feature live music, a DJ, puppet shows, storytimes, games, [guided tours](#) and [much more](#).

On June 13 **only**, visitors to the Main Library may park for **up to 12 hours** at [McKendree Garage](#), 140 6th Ave. North, for a discounted rate of \$4.00, excluding service fee and applicable taxes. (On other days, the discounted parking rate is for **up to 90 minutes**.)

NPL has teamed up with [WeGo](#) Transit to offer **free** bus passes for this event! Pick up your pass now through June 13 at the Main Library or at these branches: East, Edgehill, North, Looby, Pruitt, Hadley Park, Bellevue, Bordeaux, Madison and Richland Park.
